#### **Requirements for all scholarships:**

- Be a high school senior, **male or female**, graduating from a high school in Prince William County, Manassas, or Manassas Park, Virginia. If the applicant resides outside the Prince William County, Virginia area, the applicant must receive a written recommendation letter from an Omicron Chi Omega Chapter member.
  - (Daughters and/or sons of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Incorporated, Omicron Chi Omega Chapter members are eligible to apply and must meet all the requirements).
- Submit two reference and verification of volunteer activities forms.
- Submit a 100 to 300-word essay (double-spaced, one-inch margins, 12 font size).
- Participate in a selection panel interview.

#### **Requirements for individual scholarships:**

Mary G. Porter, Kimberly R. Davis, or Roslyn C. Dunn Scholarships, the applicant must attend a Historically Black College or University (HBCU) within one (1) year of high school graduation and have a 2.5 or above cumulative grade point average (GPA) on a 4.0 scale.

<u>Mildred C. Brown Scholarship</u>, the applicant must attend a non- HBCU, a community college, a trade and/or business school with one (1) year of high school graduation and have a 2.5 or above cumulative GPA on a 4.0 scale.

<u>Fine Arts Scholarship</u>, the applicant must attend either an HBCU or a non-HBCU and major in the Arts, within one (1) year of high school graduation and have a 2.5 or above cumulative grade point average (GPA) on a 4.0 scale and study.

<u>Chartering Scholars Award (CSA) Scholarship</u>, the applicant must attend either an HBCU or a non-HBCU, a community college, a trade and/or business school within one (1) year of high school graduation, demonstrate positive impact in the community, and have a 2.8 or above cumulative GPA on a 4.0 scale.

<u>Presidential Scholars Award (PSA) Scholarship</u>, the applicant must attend either an HBCU or a non-HBCU, a community college, a trade and/or business school within one (1) year of high school graduation, demonstrate positive impact in the community, and have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or above on a 4.0 scale.

The Mary F. Williams Educational Advancement Foundation (EAF) Scholarship, the applicant must pursue a teaching career in Prince William County. Students who plan to pursue a teaching career in Prince William County are required to indicate their intent on their application. The *EAF Scholarship* can be awarded to a student attending an HBCU or a non-HBCU.

# Incomplete applications will not be considered. Please ensure your application complete and complies with the following requirements:

- ✓ Application is typed or legibly handwritten and includes a cellphone number and email address for the applicant to receive text messages and emails regarding notification of status of the application.
- ✓ Official High school transcript.
- ✓ Two (2) volunteer verification forms for each volunteer activity to be considered.
- ✓ Two (2) character references from any combination of school, community, civic and religious leaders. *Please use the attached reference forms*.
- ✓ A 100 to 300-word essay (double-spaced, one-inch margins, 12 font size) explaining the types of volunteer activities you have participated in and what you gained from volunteering.
- ✓ If the applicant attends a high school outside of Prince William County, Manassas City or Manassas Park, include a letter of reference from an Omicron Chi Omega Chapter member.

Selection is based upon your GPA, academic potential, school and community involvement, references, your interview, and the timely return of completed application forms.
